All Levels

This basket is made from natural and dyed reed, woven so that the pattern shows through the overlying layer of reed. It has a Japanese start and is woven with a chase weave.

Couching on a Gourd
All Levels

Learn all the intricacies of the couching technique. Create a design on a gourd by stitching, at regular intervals, date palm onto the gourd surface.
